FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the New Mexico Human Rights Commission for determination of a discrimination claim based on sexual orientation, brought by the Complainant, Vanessa Willock, against the Respondent, Elane Photography, LLC. The New Mexico Human Rights Commission determines that the Complainant, Vanessa Willock, proved her discrimination claim based on sexual orientation. The Complainant proved by a preponderance of the evidence that the Respondent, Elane Photography, LLC, discriminated against her because of sexual orientation, in violation of Section 28-1-7(F) of the New Mexico Human Rights Act.

Having prevailed, the Complainant is entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees; pursuant to Section 28-1-11(E) of the New Mexico Human Rights Act.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Respondent, Elane Photography, LLC, shall pay to the Complainant, Vanessa Willock, an award for attorney's fees and costs, in the amount of \$6,637.94.
